The Ryan White Care Act provides funds to all states to establish a comprehensive community-based continuum of care, including primary medical care and support services for people with HIV infection and AIDS.

Ohio uses this money to provide services through the

- Emergency Assistance Program (food, transportation, dental, diagnostic services, counseling, etc.)
- Home Health Program
- HIV Drug Program/Health Insurance Premium Program

YOU are eligible for help through Ryan White Programs if

- You live in Ohio.
- Your doctor states that you have HIV infection.
- Your gross monthly income is less than 300% of the Federal Poverty Level.
(Larger amount is allowed if you have dependents).

If you live in one of these counties,
Defiance, Fulton, Henry, Lucas, Ottawa, Sandusky, Williams,
and Wood counties.
